

NAME

ranline – select a line at random from a file

SYNOPSIS

ranline [**-h**] *file*

DESCRIPTION

The **ranline** utility selects a line randomly from the specified *file* and writes it to standard output.

OPTIONS

-h Display a command synopsis and copyright message.

NOTES

The **ranline** utility has a 512-byte limit on line length. If it is used on files with lines longer than this, or on files that are not plain ASCII, the results are undefined.
